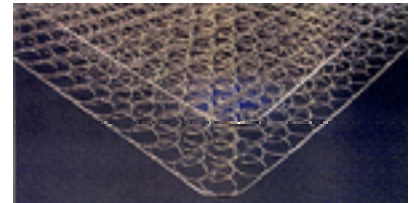
Mattress / Bed Characteristics & Features

Buying a mattress is one of the most important purchases you will make. Below is a brief overview of different mattress types explaining their different levels of functionality, comfort and sizes. While this information is designed to educate you about your options, the optimal way to choose a mattress is to visit our showroom and test the various styles we have.

- **Innerspring Mattress**

The most traditional type of mattress set, typically use systems of open coils or metal springs layered between padding. Although this type of mattress will create some motion throughout the bed, it is a more affordable option.



- **Pocketed Coil Spring Mattress**

An advanced innerspring system is where the coils are wrapped in a fabric pocket, enabling each coil to adjust independently to your body. Even if you're not sleeping alone, you can feel like you are. Because these coils can move independently, if your partner rolls over, the motions won't disturb your beauty sleep.



- **Memory Foam Mattress**

Constructed of high-density polyurethane and conform to the body to reduce pressure points and provide natural body alignment. Memory Foam Mattresses do not create much motion throughout the mattress, however, foam will retain heat and can increase the overall temperature of the mattress.



- **Air Mattress**

Uses air chambers as their primary support, a quality air mattress will mold to your body contours. Some models come



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with adjustable air chambers so you can chance your bed's firmness whenever you like.

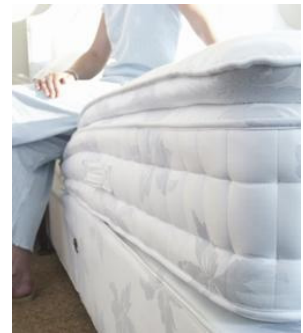
- **Adjustable Mattress**

Targeted primarily to individuals looking for anatomical support or therapeutic relief from the aches and pains associated with muscle strain and other conditions, this type of Mattress will adjust various parts of the mattress through the use of an electrical remote.



- **Pillow Tops**

Many mattresses are now offering pillow top padding for extra comfort. There are many types of pillow tops that will provide various levels of cushioning and comfort. Various products and foams are used to do so.
